Certification Process:

Participants who successfully complete any of the Scrum.org courses have the opportunity to become certified professionals in their respective areas of expertise. Scrum.org offers a rigorous certification process that validates the knowledge and skills gained from these courses.

After completing a course, participants are eligible to take the certification assessment provided by Scrum.org. This assessment consists of a series of multiple-choice questions that evaluate the participant's understanding of the course material and their ability to apply Scrum principles and practices effectively.

Here's how the certification process works:

- 1. **Course Completion:** Participants who attend the entire course and actively engage in the learning activities are eligible to take the certification assessment.
- 2. **Certification Assessment:** The certification assessment is taken online through the Scrum.org assessment platform. Participants have two attempts to pass the assessment.
- 3. **Certification:** Upon successfully passing the assessment, participants are awarded a certification by Scrum.org, recognizing their achievement and expertise in the respective Scrum domain.
- 4. **Maintaining Certification:** Scrum.org certifications do not expire, but they do require continuous learning and professional development. Certified professionals are encouraged to stay updated with the latest developments in Scrum and Agile practices to maintain the relevance of their certification.
